<p>Either of two official Spanish university qualifications: a lower qualification (known as a 'diplomatura'), equivalent to a technical diploma or degree in the UK as awarded by an institute of technology or university, or a higher qualification (known as a 'llicenciatura'), equivalent to a Bachelor's degree</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original and one photocopy of diploma or, where not available, an accredited certificate with the details of the degree awarded. In the case of UB degree holders, a transcript is sufficient.
<p>180 credits of official teaching in the first cycle, provided that the requirements established in RD 56/2005 have been met</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Academic certificate listing all credits earned, indicating fulfilment of requirements established in RD 56/2005.
<p>A non-Spanish degree accredited at the level of either of two official Spanish university qualifications: a lower qualification (known as a 'diplomatura'), equivalent to a technical diploma or degree in the UK as awarded by an institute of technology or university, or a higher qualification (known as a 'llicenciatura'), equivalent to a Bachelor's degree</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original and one photocopy of the degree's accreditation provided by the Spanish Ministry of Education and Science
<p>A non-Spanish degree not accredited at the level of either of the two official Spanish university qualifications described above</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Original of approval given by the competent UB body
<p>If you have any other training pertinent to the knowledge areas within the official Master's degree that you wish to pursue and have not had the opportunity to include it above, you must provide accredited evidence in support of it (either an original plus one photocopy or a certified photocopy).</p>
